Romans 11:7-8

⁷ What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded. (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.

Isaiah 29:10-13

 - Matthew 27:33-34 33 And when they were come unto a place called Golgotha, that is to say, a place of a skull, 34 They gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when he had tasted thereof, he would not drink.
 - Mark 15:23 Wine Mingled with Myrrh Mark 15:23 KJV ²³ And they gave him to drink wine mingled with myrrh: but he received it not.
 - Mark 15:22-23 23 NASB ²² Then they *brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull. ²³ And they tried to give Him wine mixed with myrrh; but He did not take it.

Wine Mingled with Myrrh Mark 15:23 KJV

²³ And they gave him to drink wine mingled with myrrh: but he received it not.

Wine Mingled with Myrrh Mark 15:23 NASB

²² Then they *brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull. ²³ And they tried to give Him wine mixed with myrrh; but He did not take it.

Mark 15:36 KJV – gave Him vinegar

³⁵ And some of them that stood by, when they heard it, said, Behold, he calleth Elias. ³⁶ And one ran and filled a spunge <u>full of vinegar</u>, and put it on a reed, and <u>gave him to drink</u>, saying, Let alone; let us see whether Elias will come to take him down. ³⁷ And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost.

Mark 15:36 NASB – gave Him sour wine

³⁵ And when some of the bystanders heard Him, they began saying, "Look! He is calling for Elijah!" ³⁶ And someone ran and filled a sponge with <u>sour wine</u>, put it on a reed, and <u>gave Him a drink</u>, saying, "[w]Let us see if Elijah comes to take Him down." ³⁷ But Jesus let out a loud cry, and [x]died.

²⁸ After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst. ²⁹ Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a spunge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth. ³⁰ When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Sour Wine/Vinegar

John 19:28-30 NASB

²⁸ After this, Jesus, knowing that all things had already been accomplished, in order that the Scripture would be fulfilled, *said, "I am thirsty." ²⁹ A jar full of sour wine was standing there; so they put a sponge full of the sour wine on a branch of hyssop and brought it up to His mouth. ³⁰ Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.
